

Certificate II in Engineering Studies – 22632VIC (partial)



The aim of this course is to provide pre-employment training and a pathway into the engineering, manufacturing, or related industries. Specifically, a graduate of this course will be eligible to undertake a work-based traineeship or apprenticeship in a range of engineering, manufacturing, or related areas, enrol in Certificate III qualifications in the engineering, manufacturing or related areas- seek entry level employment in the engineering, manufacturing or related industries.

Note: This is a partial course for Eaglehawk Secondary College enrolled student only. Student will receive a Statement of Attainment from the BSSC RTO on completion of these Units of Competency.

Year 1

VU23481 Apply occupational health and safety principles in an engineering environment
VU23477 Interpret and prepare basic two and three dimensional engineering drawings
VU23479 Apply basic fabrication techniques

NB: Students completing this course will receive 90 nominal hours towards VCAA credits, equal to a '1' credit. A total of 360 nominal hours is required for VCAA Unit 1, 2, 3 & 4 credits.
